SHERIFF JOHN SPEARS REPORTS THE FOLLOWING ONGOING ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR AND NARRATIVE EXCERPTS FROM THE WEEK ENDING March 27, 2017.

3/21 Sydney Kennedy, Genoa, and Isaiah Kunert, De Soto, were backing out of their parking stalls in the De Soto High School parking lot, and collided with each other. No injuries were reported.
