SHERIFF JOHN SPEARS REPORTS THE FOLLOWING ONGOING ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR AND NARRATIVE EXCERPTS FROM THE WEEK ENDING May 8, 2017.

5/7 A hunting shack on County Road XX, Town of Jefferson was reported damaged. There was a hole in the side and boards had been removed.

5/7 Sandy Ohler, LaValle, was distracted as she was maneuvering in a parking place, in the Hillsboro Country Market parking lot, Town of Hillsboro, and sideswiped a parked car belonging to Kelsey Skala, Hillsboro. The vehicles suffered minor damage and no one was injured.

5/7 A fire number sign and several fence posts were hit at a property on County Road Y, Town of Jefferson.

5/7 Brian Lighthizer, West Bend, was pulling a camper, on County Road EE, Town of Greenwood, when a vehicle driven by Jolee Mockler, LaValle, came through the intersection at County Road Q, and struck the Lighthizer truck. The Lighthizer truck and camper went over an embankment, rolling several times. The Mockler vehicle also went over an embankment and rolled. Both vehicles were towed. Lightizer and Mockler sustained possible injuries.

The sheriff's office has received more scam reports. Please try to educate yourself on the possible ploys scammers are using. Some tips: Do not give the scammers money in ANY way. This includes getting cash cards and providing them with the numbers and PINs. Do not provide any personal checking, savings, or credit card account information. Do not deal with unknown entities in internet sales. If you do want to conduct business on the internet, be sure to investigate the credibility of the buyer/seller, and use secure accounts to send or receive payments.
