SHERIFF JOHN SPEARS REPORTS THE FOLLOWING ONGOING ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR AND NARRATIVE EXCERPTS FROM THE WEEK ENDING February 19, 2018.

02/15 Keonte Turner, La Crosse, was traveling eastbound on US Highway 14, Town of Franklin, when he hit a patch of ice and lost control of the vehicle. Turner's vehicle left the roadway, drove down an embankment, and went through a barbed wire fence. The vehicle continued through another fence before striking a large rock in a creek where it came to rest. Turner reported minor injuries, and the vehicle was towed due to disabling damage.

02/17 Deven Nietzold, Westby, was traveling eastbound on County Road Y, Town of Harmony, with his passenger, Cohner Fish, Viroqua. Nietzold turned right to travel southbound on County Road O. Due to speed and road conditions, the front of Nietzold's vehicle started to slide across the centerline, striking the front driver's side tire of a northbound vehicle driven by Link Buckles, Viroqua. Buckles attempted to steer into the ditch to avoid the collision. Both vehicles came to rest in the northbound ditch and were towed due to disabling damage. No injuries were reported.

02/17 Darrell Parrish, Galesville, was driving southbound on Ladwig Hill Road, Town of Genoa, when he went off the left side of the road and hit a fence owned by Arnold Trussoni. Neither Parrish nor his passenger, Susan Parrish, reported injuries. The vehicle was towed due to disabling damage.

02/17 Phia Vang, La Crosse, reported a hit-and-run at Tuna's Bar in Genoa. There was minimal damage to his vehicle.

02/18 Matthew Gerth, Westby, was negotiating a curve while driving southbound on Nottingham Road, Town of Jefferson. Gerth was traveling too fast and lost control of his vehicle. The vehicle went off the left side of the road, striking a pole shed owned by Karl Wilttrout, Viroqua. Wilttrout reported damage to the shed and items inside. Gerth reported no injuries, and his vehicle was towed.
