## **SHERIFF JOHN SPEARS REPORTS THE FOLLOWING ONGOING ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR AND NARRATIVE EXCERPTS FROM THE WEEK ENDING May 21, 2018.**

05/14                      Jonathan Daffinson, Holmen, was driving eastbound on US Highway 14, Town of Christiana. Daffinson and his passenger, William Lachman Jr., stated they saw something flash in front of them, heard a loud bang, and then noticed a crack in the windshield. The unknown object caused a circular crack approximately 2 inches in diameter.
