## SHERIFF JOHN SPEARS REPORTS THE FOLLOWING ONGOING ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR AND NARRATIVE EXCERPTS FROM THE WEEK ENDING May 21, 2018.

Jonathan Daffinson, Holmen, was driving eastbound on US Highway 14, Town of Christiana. Daffinson and his passenger, William Lachman Jr., stated they saw something flash in front of them, heard a loud bang, and then noticed a crack in the windshield. The unknown object caused a circular crack approximately 2 inches in diameter.

05/17 Cali Cauffman, Viroqua, was traveling westbound on County Road SS, Town of Liberty, when she lost control while negotiating a curve. The vehicle fishtailed causing it to enter the ditch on the north side of the road. Cauffman's vehicle traveled approximately 50 feet through the grass and struck a tree.
