SHERIFF JOHN SPEARS REPORTS THE FOLLOWING ONGOING ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR AND NARRATIVE EXCERPTS FROM THE WEEK ENDING February 4, 2019.

01/28 Vicki Peterson, Casey, IA, was operating a semi-truck and trailer for Aschenbrenner Trucking, Inc. Peterson was traveling northbound on State Highway 35, Town of Bergen, and drove onto the shoulder of the road where there was deep snow.
