SHERIFF JOHN SPEARS REPORTS THE FOLLOWING ONGOING ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR AND NARRATIVE EXCERPTS FROM THE WEEK ENDING April 8, 2019.

04/02 Carol Silvers, Gays Mills, was traveling westbound on State Highway 56, town of Viroqua. Silvers activated her left turn signal, and started to slow down to turn into a private driveway. Marianne Miller, Viola, was traveling behind the Silvers vehicle. To avoid rear ending the Silvers vehicle, Miller swerved to the left, and side swiped the Silvers vehicle. The impact caused the Silvers vehicle to spin around. The Miller vehicle backed up, and scrapped the side of the Silvers vehicle. No injuries were reported. Both vehicles received functional damage.

04/02 David Hendricks, Stoddard, was backing out of a private lot on Proksch Coulee Road, town of Bergen. As Hendricks turned to the east, he did not notice the vehicle parked behind him.
