SHERIFF JOHN SPEARS REPORTS THE FOLLOWING ONGOING ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR AND NARRATIVE EXCERPTS FROM THE WEEK ENDING April 29, 2019.

04/25 Kay Frydenlund, Coon Valley, was traveling on Hohlfeld Road in the town of Hamburg. Frydenlund hit debris on the side of the road, and over corrected. The vehicle turned onto its side, rolled over, and came to a rest on its wheels on the opposite side of the road. Frydenlund reported no injuries at the time of the crash. The vehicle was towed due to disabling damage.

04/25 Kelsey Freymiller, Viroqua, was traveling northbound on County Road S, town of Liberty. Freymiller stated she swerved to avoid hitting a deer.
